All babies and children have regular access to the amazing Sensory Room, where twinkling leaf shaped lights are changed by the movement and sounds made by the children themselves.

All staff have a comprehensive package of training and further qualifications and professional development is encouraged. It is very important that you know that your baby is being cared in a safe, happy and nurturing environment with staff who know your baby well. Babies from 3 months years of age are welcomed into our Baby Snug and we undertake a careful induction programme with you and your baby before their first session at Brighter Futures.

Our baby Snug is managed by Mrs Rachel Withey, who has years of experience at working at some of the best baby rooms in the country, as well as being an experienced Nanny, Child Minder and mother herself. Rachel ensures that every baby and toddler enjoys a fun play environment with feeding, changing and sleeping routines carefully adhered to.

Each day babies and toddlers will be able to explore activities appropriate to their interests and development, including natural lots of sensory experiences with Treasure Baskets, heuristic play, paint, sand and water, and other exciting materials to explore safely. Natural materials and objects are available to help children explore the world around them and develop their natural curiosities. Lots of singing, music and rhythm is enjoyed as are books and stories appropriate to the age and ability of each child. Babies and toddlers enjoy plenty of fresh air outside in the sensory garden, where toddlers can wear all in one waterproofs to explore and have fun!

Your baby will have a Key Person who will link closely with you to share information and discuss any aspect of your baby's care and development. Your baby's Key Person will talk to you about the routines you have at home, special words and objects that are familiar to your baby and your baby's likes and dislikes and developing personality. We understand that the smoother the transition from home to nursery is for your baby, the better it will be for everyone. Above all we keep the needs of your baby at the heart of everything we do, treating every child as an individual with activities and routines matched to meet the unique and changing needs of each child.

Flexible childcare packages enable you to choose whether you want to provide milk feeds and foods yourself or whether for an additional charge you would like this included in your childcare package. Similarly, you can choose to provide all nappies, creams and wipes yourself.

Our Movers and Shakers!



Children from the age of 2 are welcomed into the Movers and Shakers Room, a stimulating, attractive and nurturing environment for children to develop their learning and have lots of fun!

The environment is meticulously planned and organised to enable all areas of learning to be available for children through their play. We have a Build It Zone, where children have access to a wide range of blocks and bricks and are encouraged to work out problems and develop their imaginations. In the Messy Zone children explore sensory experiences as well as thinking about the properties of textures and how things move, such as sand, water, gloop and dough. In the Explore It Zone children can help themselves to materials to help them learn about the natural world, such as magnifying glasses, torches, metal detectors and cameras. The Book Zone contains a range of lovely books, including beautiful picture books, story and non fiction books such as map and flag books and manuals for cars.

All children have regular opportunities to explore our beautiful sensory room, where coloured lights twinkle and change as children clap their hands and use their voice.

Children also have the opportunity to go on local trips out, including to the swimming pool, library, theatre, park and fruit picking. We help all children to enjoy the exciting things on offer in Malvern and surrounding places.

Brighter Futures Nursery invests heavily in the highest calibre staff team who know the children really well and so are able to develop each child's thinking and learning, all by having a brilliant time having lots of fun!
